



Fee Agreement

PLEASE NOTE THE QDRO PROCESS CAN TAKE UP TO 3 MONTHS. Simply QDROs will complete the first four (4) steps in the process, and the family law attorney(s) will complete the remaining two (2) steps. Below are the estimated time frames.

Review submitted documents. Request plan procedures from Plan Admin	1 day
Review plan procedures. Draft preliminary QDRO and submit to Plan Admin	1 - 2 days
Plan Admin reviews preliminary QDRO and issues pre-approval letter	30 - 45 days
Forward pre-approved QDRO to Family Law Attorneys	1 day
Family Law Attorneys submit the pre-approved QDRO to the court for the Judge's review/signature and filing with the Clerk's office.	14 - 21 days
Family Law Attorneys submit the judge-signed order to the Plan Admin for final approval. Plan Admin creates temporary account holding the funds, and notifies spouse/former spouse.	30 - 45 days

Services specifically not included are as follows:

1. Calculations or valuations
2. Providing legal, financial, or tax advice to either party
3. Filing any enforcement action if one party refuses to cooperate

After receipt of the above documents, we will email the paying party(ies) a payment link. Upon payment, we will begin work.
